

Dormition Guild Icon Project

October 2017

Father Constantine White, former Dean of the Cathedral, in late 2008 expressed the need to complete the Cathedral's set of Triodion/Pentecostarion Sunday Icons (Pre-Fast, Fast and Post-Paschal). An Icon Project plan was approved at our Dormition Guild meeting in February 2009. For the first phase, the Icon Committee with Father Constantine's assistance, selected 16 mounted icon reproductions in size 11"x14" from Holy Transfiguration Monastery, St. Isaac of Syria Skete or Uncut Mountain Supply. The icons were hung in the choir loft at the suggestion of Guild President, Mark Pietrzykoski. This proved to be the perfect place to both store and display all the icons of our Project.

The second phase of the Project, to commission **original icons for the Major Feast Days** of the Orthodox Church, began in 2010. Father Constantine recommended that the icons be 14"x 18" size so that they would be smaller than the Cathedral's Resurrection Icon. In addition, Father suggested that to have the icons written/painted by iconographers who were present or past members of St. Nicholas Cathedral would be especially meaningful. Iconographers Matushka Anna Danylevich, Colette Kalvesmaki, Maria Manley, Steve Terrell and Nadine Kastelan Thola were sent a Memo of Inquiry of Interest and responded as shown in the tables below. We are thankful to those iconographers who responded and are grateful to parishioners who came forward to sponsor these beautiful icons. The icons are hung on the choir loft banister.

For the third and final phase of our Project, the Guild solicited sponsors for **originals of the Triodion/ Pentecostarion Icons**. The size is 11"x14", smaller than the Feast Day icons. All these icons have now been sponsored and the remaining one, Publican and Pharisee, is scheduled to be received later this year.

Parishioners also requested to sponsor two additional icons, Synaxis of the Archangel Michael and the Bodiless Powers, and New Martyrs of Russia. Archangel Michael has been received and New Martyrs is scheduled to be received later this year. Thanks be to God.

Through the help of Elizabeth Slanta, Member of the Board of the Orthodox Christian Mission Center, our mounted icon reproductions were donated to Bishop David of Alaska for distribution to parishes there. Most will be given to St. Michael the Archangel Parish in Eek, Alaska.

We thank all those who have sponsored these 30 beautiful icons of our Dormition Guild Icon Project. See icon lists with sponsors, memorials and iconographers on the pages below. Engraved plaques with this information will be attached to the back of each icon.
