

DORMITION GUILD ICON PROJECT
February 2009 - October 2018

In late 2008 Father Constantine White expressed the need to complete the Cathedral's set of Triodion/Pentecostarion Sunday Icons (Pre-Fast, Fast and Post-Paschal). An Icon Project plan was approved at our Dormition Guild meeting in February 2009. For the first phase, the Icon Committee with Father Constantine's assistance selected 16 mounted **icon reproductions** in size 11"x14" from Holy Transfiguration Monastery, St. Isaac of Syria Skete or Uncut Mountain Supply.

The second phase of the Project, to commission **original icons of the Major Feast Days** of the Orthodox Church, began in 2010. Father Constantine recommended that the icons be size 14"x18" so that they would be smaller than the Cathedral's Resurrection Icon. In addition, Father suggested that to have the icons written/painted by iconographers who were present or past members of St. Nicholas Cathedral, would be especially meaningful. Iconographers Matushka Anna Danylevich, Colette Kalvesmaki, Maria Manley, Steve Terrell and Nadine Kastelan Thola were sent a Memo of Inquiry of Interest and responded as shown in the tables below. We are thankful to those iconographers who responded and are grateful to parishioners who came forward to sponsor these beautiful icons. The icons are displayed on the choir loft banister.

For the third and final phase of our Project, sponsors were solicited for **originals of the Triodion/Pentecostarion Icons**. The size is 11"x14", so that they are smaller than the Feast Day icons. Again, parishioners came forward to sponsor these 17 icons. The mounted reproductions of these icons were donated to Bishop David of Alaska for distribution to parishes there. Most were to be given to St. Michael the Archangel Parish in Eek, Alaska. Parishioners also requested to sponsor two additional icons.

All Icons of our Project were received as of January 19, 2018. We thank all those who sponsored these 30 beautiful icons. See icon lists with sponsors, memorials and iconographers on the pages below and also at the Cathedral posted on the bulletin board downstairs. Engraved plaques indicating this information have now been affixed to the back of each icon.

The Guild Icon Project took nine years to complete. Glory to God for all things!
